#### Barat College of DePaul University Chicago, 1999-2004

- B.A. in *Acting & Directing* Studied acting for four years and directing for two. Gradually my focus shifted more and more towards directing. I performed in 10 main stage shows and directed several productions independently of the theatre school.
- B.A. in *Economics* For my senior capstone I researched and created a business plan for starting a nonprofit production company based in Chicago. This became the original vision for Oracle Productions
- Graduated *Cum Laude* and received *Departmental Honors* in both majors.

#### Theatre Administration:

#### Artistic Director | ORACLE PRODUCTIONS, NFP | 2003-2008

- Oracle Productions started at Barat College and we produced shows independently of the theatre department. We incorporated the company in 2004 as a nonprofit, with the intent of continuing to produce after college in Chicago. I procured the start up capital, created the organization's initial by-laws, and functioned as the organization's entrepreneur, creating the mission and strategy for breaking into the saturated Chicago market.
- I served as the founding Artistic Director, and directed all our productions from 2003 until 2006. In 2004 I spearheaded the opening of the ORACLE THEATRE in Chicago, a 40-seat black box venue. I oversaw Oracle's structural development, led the ensemble through 4 seasons, began the company's board development, and ran the business. In 2006, I became

the organization's primary production manager out of developmental necessity until my departure in 2008.

#### Executive Director | Studio BE, NFP - MCL CHICAGO | 2009-2015

- 2009-2010 Conceived, co-founded, and incorporated a unique organization dedicated to performing arts education and non-profit development in Chicago's Lakeview neighborhood. In year 1 I wrote the organization's business plan, bylaws, obtained 40k in funding, signed a lease to a 3000 sq ft storefront, built it into a 100 seat venue, obtained a PerformingArtsVenue license and 501©(3) status, and launched our first residency program, our first summer camp, and first year of after school programming.
- 2010-2011 I oversaw our second full season of youth programming, launched our first partnership with Columbia College's CCAP afterschool program. I expanded our rental revenue by 100%, booked & managed the venue for over 30 tenants, planned and managed budgets and payroll, and oversaw the growth of an operational budget of 40k (yr 1) to over 120k (yr 2).
- 2011-2012 I oversaw our third full season of youth programming, began partnerships with 3 CPS schools, expanded our in house programming 50%, obtained over 30k in fundraising, and completed our three year plan to open a new venue for our resident company. Initiated an original co-production of successful satire with 4 Day's Late Productions of Jersey Shore The Musical. The production ran mostly sold out for nearly 10 months. Expanded our revenue from 120k (yr 2) to 300k (yr3)
- 2013-2015 Studio BE split into two separate organizations and restructured. I spearheaded the transition of the Studio BE venue into Music Comedy Live Chicago. MCL Chicago launched officially in August of 2014, completely renovated and with a new mission. MCL Chicago is the only venue in the country dedicated to fostering and producing the emerging art form of improvised music comedy. This transition has allowed me to pursue a more focused freelancing career.

#### Production Manager | Victory Gardens Theatre | 2016-2018

- In 2016 I joined the team at Victory Gardens as the full time production manager. I was in charge of the entirety of the production department and oversaw several full time positions; Technical Director, Master Electrician, Sound Supervisor, as well as all part time production staff per production. I was in charge of our USA CBA and handled negotiations and executions. During my time at Victory Gardens I managed over 3 million dollars of resources.
- Victory Gardens produced 5 mainstage shows each season. For these shows I submitted budgets for approval, hired design teams, set and enforced all production deadlines, managed a team of technicians and staff, was responsible for safety measures, and was generally responsible for incredibly complex artistic collaboration processes.
- I was the point person for all resident organizations, events, and served as the primary liaison for all venue rental needs.

#### Production Manager | Emerald City Theatre | Sept 2018 - Jan 2020

In 2018 I started as the full time production manager with Emerald City. Within 3 months I
was asked to join the Senior Staff.

- Emerald City boasted the largest amount of youth programming in Chicago. I was the primary point of contact for venue relations where the organization produced projects. I staffed and contracted all technical staff, was responsible for safety measures, and was generally responsible for incredibly complex artistic collaboration processes.
- Was given a \$2000 bonus at 6 month review.
- Sadly the company dissolved in Jan 2020.

#### General Manager | Criterion Productions | Sept 2018 - Feb 2020

- I served as a freelance employee as a General Manager for two commercial productions.
- I generated project proposals to Producers, budget estimates, P&L analysis and projections, and monthly and weekly financial analysis.
- I built the production processes from scratch for producers. This included contracting 100% of employees from actors, designers, creatives, and run crews. I was the primary point of contact between producers and all staff.
- I was the point negotiator for the actors union, musician's union, and United Scenic Artists (designer union).
- Ultimately I managed \$2 million dollars in receipts and all revenues, working with accountants to properly structure and organize investments, sponsors, and LLC structures.

#### Interim Director of Production | Chicago Opera Theater | Dec 2019 - Feb 2020
